The 'Horseshoe' Timber sale would:

- Log an area surrounded on all sides by federal protected forest: Mt. Hood Wilderness, the Bullock Watershed, the Wild and Scenic Sandy River
- Log in critical salmon habitat and the only area in Mt. Hood National Forest where salmon numbers are actually rising
- Backpedal on decades of forest recovery in an area that has had a moratorium on logging since 1998
- Log old growth and never-before-logged forest
- Destroy your favorite trail!
